# STEP 2

## *Meet your mentor*

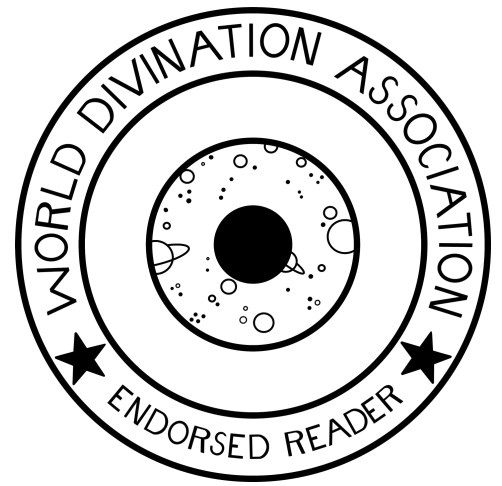
Once you have chosen your system you will be assigned a mentor to navigate you through the Program. Your mentor will be a WDA Endorsed Reader or Endorsed Teacher in your chosen system. They will test you through a series readings and help you find your perfect reading style that will boost your confidence and also enable you to become adapt at working with querents.



# STEP 3

## *Understand the process*

Your mentor will always point you in the right direction!  
The process is simple to follow in our private Facebook members group or alternatively on our WDA Forum.



## LEVEL 1 - BRONZE

10 supervised reads (max 2 per week)

3 - 5 card spreads

Reader must understand the card meanings and basic placements

Themes for reads will include:

Work, Relationships, Pros & Cons, Comparison Reads.

## LEVEL 2 - SILVER

10 supervised reads (max 2 per week)

Spreads must include at least 5 to 9 cards

Reader must understand system techniques and develop a clear reading style.

Mentor a Bronze Level member or provide engagement in groups.

Themes for reads will include:

Work, Relationships, Pros & Cons, Comparison Reads.

## LEVEL 3 - GOLD

Discuss a role at the WDA! Mentoring or as simple as posting exercises, creating engagement in the groups or becoming part of the WDA Team!

Completion of 2 full GT submitted to the relevant teacher or 5 spreads larger than 10 cards for systems with no GT



# THE RULES

*We have a system of rules to make your life easier!*

## READING BASICS

1. Concise question asked and answer given (never tangent).
2. Refrain from Yes/No questions
3. Readings must show the meaning of the cards not rely on intuition alone (a mix of the two is allowed).
4. The earliest instructions MUST be used for the basis of reading.
5. State card names in interpretation.
6. The supervised readings are considered “successful” if no request is made by your mentor to revisit.
7. Only reads without a suggested improvement will be counted.

## ETHICAL READING

- a) Student Readers must identify themselves as such and tag their mentor into all interpretations.
- b) WDA Endorsed Readers are students that have completed a cartomancy course & successfully performed readings under supervision.
- c) Readings are only performed for persons aged 18 years or older.
- d) Readings are to be well considered with clear intention.
- e) Readers should be open-minded, honest and non-judgmental
- f) If, at any time, you feel uncomfortable with the reading you should withdraw immediately and with tact.
- g) Questions are clearly formulated and relayed to the querent.
- h) Questions shall directly relate to the querent.
- i) The cards show a possible outcome at this time and place.
